RE: CALL TO ANNUAL MEETING

Notice is hereby given that our President, Ed Aycock, has designated that the Annual Meeting of the National Retriever Club, Incorporated, shall be held in Ardmore, Oklahoma at the Elks Lodge, 2526 S. Commerce, Ardmore, OK on Saturday, November 11, 2000 at 3:00 p.m. or upon the conclusion of the American Kennel Club's Retriever Advisory Committee which latter meeting has been called for 2:00 p.m. on the same day at the same location.

It is hoped that each of the Member Clubs will be represented, preferably by its Delegate, otherwise by proxy.

If your Club is to be represented by your Delegate, whose name appears in the upper left hand corner of this letter, no proxy is needed. If your Club does not have a delegate, or if it desires to be represented by someone other than its duly appointed Delegate, will each Secretary please complete and return the proxy form enclosed to the National Retriever Club Secretary. Delegates do not appoint proxies.

At times in the past, persons named as proxy have not been present, or although present, have been ineligible because of the provision contained in ARTICLE III, Section 4 of the Club's by-laws that no person can represent more than two (2) clubs as delegate or proxy. In order to afford Member Clubs the opportunity of being represented in such eventualities, and to help insure that a quorum will be present, the enclosed proxy form has been drawn so that a Member Club may authorize the Secretary/Treasurer or the President of the National Retriever Club, Incorporated to name an alternate in the absence, or inability to act, of the named proxy.
