Ranger was the product of two untitled dogs and was the last puppy left in a litter of eight. When people would view the pups, he would go hide in the corner, but his shyness didn't last for long. As an adult when he went to the line he strutted as if to say 'watch me'. To date, he is still my number one.

His accomplishments include the following:

- FC at age 4
- Qualified for 9 Nationals in 5 years which included time off for a ruptured Achilles Tendon (06) and an ACL rupture (07)
- He was awarded a Jam or placed in 41% of all trials entered (Open and Amateur)
- He was awarded a Jam or placed in 50% of all Amateurs entered
- He was awarded 66.5 Open points and 88 Amateur points (92% with Amateur Handler)
- 2005 High Point Open dog
- Double Header winner
- National Amateur Finalist 2003 (3 years old)
- National Amateur Finalist 2004 (4 years old)
- National Open Finalist 2004 (4 years old)
- He averaged 14 Opens and 10 Amateurs / year
- Sired many Derby List dogs
- Sired 2009 High Point Open Female
- Sired 2010 National Field Champion
- Sired 2010 National Amateur Finalist
- Sired #2 High Point Derby dog
- Sired 2011 National Amateur Finalist
- Sired the 2009 combined high point Open and AM dog

He has produced more titled dogs than the number of times he was bred and was Awarded the Thomas W. Merritt Trophy for 2011. This award recognizes the Sire whose progeny were awarded the largest number of All-Age points in the previous calendar year.

In his last year he ran 6 Opens (receiving a JAM or placing in 4 of the events) and competed in the National Amateur, where he went 9 series largely running on 3 legs. He was then retired and the following December 24th, he had to be sent over the Bridge.
